LOCATION AND SCHEDULE OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament will be held at Memorial University of Newfoundland at the St. John's Campus. The playing area will be the Gushue Hall Dining Room which is part of Paton College. The tournament will run from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Sunday, May 20 & 8:45 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday, May 21, 2018. The tournament site is a 2 min walk from the Paton College residences.

AIRPORT ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

We will arrange a shuttle to pick-up and drop-off for each visiting province, getting to and from the tournament. This will be available from noon on Thursday, May 17 to noon on Tuesday, May 22. The airport is just 15 minutes from the campus by car/taxi.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Memorial University Residence – Paton College

The residence for the event will be Paton College which is close to Prince Phillip Drive (the main road that runs through the St. John's campus). Paton College consists of a number of residence buildings and includes Gushue Hall and Hatcher House. The playing area will be the Gushue Hall Dining Hall. The Saturday evening banquet will also be in the Dining Hall in Gushue Hall. All other meals will be served in Hatcher House. Rooms are organized with two single beds, double occupancy. (There are no single rooms, though rooms with one double bed are available on request at \$82 per night). Rooms include a desk, a chair, a dresser and a closet. Linens and towels are provided. There shared communal washrooms on each floor. Please note that room rates do not include any meals. Check-In is at the main desk of the MacPherson residence which is at 40 Livyer's Loop, opposite Hatcher House.

All players must pay for their rooms.

There is a full size swimming pool (The Aquarena) on the university campus which is 8 minutes' walk from Paton College (slightly longer via the university tunnel system).

Hotels and Other Accommodation

There are numerous hotels and bed and breakfasts within easy reach of the University Campus. The Guvnor Inn on Elizabeth Avenue is the about 15 minutes' walk to the playing area (in Gushue Hall). There are other hotels nearby (such as the Holiday Inn on Prince Phillip Drive). There also are many other good hotels and bed and breakfasts in the downtown area which is less than 10 minutes' drive by car (or about 15 minutes on the bus) from the University Campus.

Buses downtown run once every half hour on Saturday and once per hour on Sunday and the Holiday Monday. The bus schedules are available on from the St. John's Metrobus web site at https://www.metrobus.com/html-default/schedules/schedules_fall.asp or their app.

ORGANIZED MEALS

A banquet is organized for Saturday May 20 at 5:30 pm at the University in the playing hall (in Gushue Hall). Cost is \$20 per person. This will include entertainment by local artists/performers.

All other meals (i.e. breakfasts and lunches) will be served in the Hatcher House Dining Room which is on the ground floor of Hatcher House. Hatcher House also part of Paton College and is adjacent to Gushue Hall. (See the campus map at http://www.mun.ca/campus_map/).

There are also a number of other good food establishments of different sorts within 10-15 min walk of the university, including several in nearby Churchill Square. The Avalon Mall shopping center is within 5 minutes' drive or about 40 minutes' walk of the university campus. Several buses run between the University and the Avalon Mall.

OTHER CHESS ACTIVITIES

A speed chess tournament (Blitz) will be organized take place at 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, May 19 with a pre-registration cost of \$10 (\$15 on site).

Bughouse (double blitz – 5 rounds) will take place following the awards ceremony on Monday, May 21 with a cost of \$5 (\$10 on site).

Both Blitz and Bughouse are open events. Parents, friends and the members of the public are also welcome to play.

We will also be showing the chess themed movie, the Queen of Katwe in the Bruneau Innovation Centre Lecture Hall starting at 7:00 pm on Saturday May 19 (i.e. following the banquet). The Bruneau Innovation Centre is next to the QE2 Library, 5 minutes' walk from Paton College. (See the campus map at http://www.mun.ca/campus_map/).

There may also be a *Simul* on Saturday morning. Details to follow once they are available.

Bus Tour on Saturday Morning

A special guided bus tour has been arranged for the Saturday, morning from 9am to 12 noon. The plan is for the tour to include local sights such as Signal Hill, Cape Spear (subject to the weather) and the Geo Centre. Cape Spear is the most easterly point in North America.

The cost of this is \$22 per adult, \$15 per player (or school aged sibling). All children (under 16) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Spaces on this tour are strictly limited by the bus size so, to be fair to all provinces, if the tour is oversubscribed, we will fill places based on a draw. (Family groups will be kept together).
