What: The scholastic team tournaments are among the most popular events of the year as students

may represent their school as a team. Each school's team is formed by four players who will be positioned according to their strength (the strongest player will play on the first board, second strongest on second board, etc.). The teacher and the players will determine in advance the team's name and each player's position on the board. **This tournament is so much fun**,

the kids want more!

Entry of players in the tournament hall: 11:15 AM. Tournament: 11:30 to 4:30-5:00PM (Please note that parents cannot enter the tournament room except at the 2nd or 3rd round to take pictures or at the discretion of the Tournament Director. Due to the popularity of this event we suggest

that only one person accompanies your child to the tournament until the award ceremony)

Categories: Kindergarten to grade 3 / High School / Individual

Prizes: A trophy goes to the school of the champion teams of all sections for one year. The winning teams of the

A sections will receive plaques. The winning teams of the other sections will receive a plaque for their school, and medals (Primary and 3rd place for High School) or plaques (1st and 2nd place for

High School). Individual category: Medals for the 3 best results in each section.

Fee: \$30 per child

Notes: Qualification for the Quebec-Ontario Chess Challenge which will take place in June. The top 3 teams in

mat-3, mat-6 and High School will represent Quebec at this tournament. If the teacher cannot form a

team, your child can play in the individual section.

Other: Time control: 20 minutes + 5 seconds incrementation. 5 games will be played by each of the

participants/teams. Prize ceremony at the end of the tournament. You can bring your own

lunch and there will be a cafeteria onsite as well.
