The Quebec Chess Challenge is an opportunity for young people from all over Quebec to participate in the biggest youth tournament of the year. The QCC is a tournament by school grade open to young people from kindergarten to CEGEP 1 (grade 12). This year the QCC will take place at the Montreal Congress Center on Sunday April 28th, 2024!

In order to participate in the QCC, young people must be in the top 10 for their school grade on December 1st 2023, or qualify in a qualification tournament.

The winners from each grade from grade 1 to CEGEP 1 will represent Quebec at the National Chess Challenge which will take place in New Brunswick on May 19th and 20th, 2024.

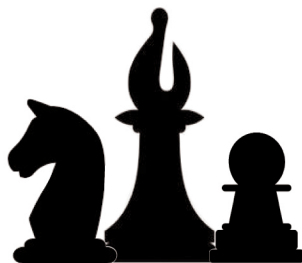
Schedule : The tournament begins at **11:30AM**
