Categories: Kindergarten to grade 3 / High School / Individual

Prizes: A trophee goes to the school of the winning teams of each section for one year. Plaques will be

awarded to all the players of the 1st and 2nd winning teams. Players of the 3rd winning teams will be awarded medals. Individual category: Medals for the 3 best results in each section.

We will give the teachers their registrations so they can form their team. An email will be

sent out no later than the Friday before the tournament with all of the details.

Fee: \$25 per player.

Other: Time control: 20 minutes + 5 seconds incrementation. 5 games will be played by each of the

participants/teams. Prize ceremony at the end of the tournament. You can bring your own

lunch and there will be a canteen onsite as well.
