

Qualification Tournaments

for the Quebec Chess Challenge 2025

The Quebec chess championship 2025 by school grade Kindergarten - CEGEP I (grade 12)

On Sundays December 8th, February 9th and April 13th

The Quebec Chess Challenge is an opportunity for young people from all over Quebec to participate in the biggest youth tournament of the year. The QCC is a tournament by school grade open to young people from kindergarten to CEGEP 1 (grade 12). This year the QCC will take place in Montreal on April 2025!

In order to participate in the QCC, young people must be in the top 10 for their school grade on December 1st 2024, or qualify in a qualification tournament.

The winners from each grade from grade 1 to CEGEP 1 will represent Quebec at the National Chess Challenge which will take place in Ottawa on May 18th and 19th, 2025.

On-site registrations are between 10:30 AM and 11:15 AM Participants who register after 11:15 AM will miss the first game

Schedule: The tournament starts at 11:30 AM and ends between 4:30 PM and 5:00 PM. 5-round tournament. Time of play: 20 min + 5 sec inc.
